5th **Grade Yearbook**- The 5th grade yearbook committee will be using Canva- a free online service- to layout the yearbook. There is still a \$375 gap between budget and the lowest quote we have received for printing. Discussion about how to make up the shortfall. There may be some extra funds we can utilize from the 5th grade fundraising. They had the new movie night concessions they don't usually have. The PTC budget is also doing well so there may be some places to reallocate funds there too. Decided to table the discussion until April/May. The printing won't happen until then.

Big Frog- Discussion about giving our logo to Big Frog Custom T-shirts. Ryan at Big Frog said they will set up a customer folder under Hiteon PTC, and anyone who comes in a mentions Hiteon PTC will be given wholesale pricing. A standard T-shirt printed through them would run \$12.39 and a standard long sleeve would be \$16.39. The board agreed this would give the Hiteon community easy access to Hiteon Apparel and agreed to move forward.
