

HITEON PTC VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES 2015-2016

*****HITEON FUN RUN***** – This is our primary fundraiser of the year where students seek pledges for running and take pride in being physically active. Help count number of laps, collect contribution envelopes, hand out snacks and water, and cheer on our Hiteon Hawks. Loads of fun!! Many volunteers needed to make this a success! We need both committee volunteers and day of event volunteers.

Event Dates: April 14-15, 2016

Art Literacy - The program consists of volunteers who go into classrooms to give a visual presentation on an artist which is followed by a hands-on art project with the students. Typically during the year, there are six different lessons presented. Monthly training sessions provided.

Training Dates: Oct. 6, Nov. 10, 2015, Jan. 5, Feb. 9, Apr. 5, May 10, 2016

Bingo Night – Set up and staff an evening of family fun.

Event Date: Feb. 26, 2016

Box Tops/Label for Education – Cut/count box tops and soup labels (can be done at home). Two classroom contests are run during the year with the winning classrooms receiving a special treat

Book Fair – Assist with sales of books for this library fundraiser. Volunteers needed to set up and break down as well.

Event Dates: Oct. 26-30, 2015

Classroom Coordinators (formerly known as Room Parents) – Help the teacher with specific classroom needs: organizing volunteers for special events (ex. reward parties for box tops or Fun Run). Help plan and coordinate two 1-hour classroom parties (Winter, End of Year) Parties generally include a craft, snack, and a game/activity. Coordinate the Staff Appreciation Week Activities for your class.

Event Dates: Dec. 18, 2015 (Winter Party), May 2-6, 2016 (Staff Appreciation), Jun. 15 or 16, 2016 (End of Year Party)

Classroom Helper – Help the teacher with specific classroom needs: preparing take home folders, copying, grading, filing, die cutting, sharpening pencils, helping with reading or math groups, etc.

Class Party Helper - Help set-up, supervise and clean-up two 1-hour classroom parties (Winter, End of Year) Parties generally include a craft, snack, and a game/activity.

Event Dates: Dec. 18, 2015 (Winter Party), Jun. 15 or 16, 2016 (End of Year Party)

Clothes Closet – Volunteers staff this valuable district resource for needy families in our community. Training provided; Hiteon is assigned one day to fill shifts.

Family Art and Culture Night – Display student artwork, set-up stations and assist with projects at this evening event, and clean-up.

Event Date: Jun. 2, 2016

Family Dance – Help with set up, cleanup, check-in, or chaperone at our rockin' DJ'd dance.

Event Date: Nov. 13, 2015

Field Day – Lots of volunteers needed to help run fun game stations/activities, supervise students, and hand out snacks/water during this great year end event coordinated by our PE teacher.

Event Date: Jun. 10, 2016

5th Grade Parent Coordinators – Plan and help with send-off party, help organize the Colonial Fair, work on the yearbook for documenting all those 5th grade memories

Garden Committee - Parent volunteers working with the staff to maintain and enhance the garden boxes at school for the learning and enjoyment of the students.

Hearing Day – Help gather students when needed and guide through stations, as well as assist in testing with hearing.

Event Date: Apr. 7, 2016, Apr. 11, 2016 (re-screen)

Library – Help check-in materials, resshelf books, and tidy shelves. Help students find appropriate reading level books.

Lost and Found Crew – Help clean up, tag and manage the lost and found cart. Periodically launder and transport unclaimed items to the Beaverton Clothes Closet.

Math Labs (3rd/4th Grade) - As a math lab classroom volunteer you will be working with a group of five to six students on addition, subtraction, multiplication and division problems. The students will be divided into groups based on assessments done by the teachers. Programs are generally run once a week but volunteers are welcome to come weekly, bi-weekly, once a month or as needed.

Once a week (Oct. – May) day of the week TBD

Passport Club (1st-5th Grade) – Once a month volunteers help quiz students and hand out stamps and maps for our great geography program. No Prior geography knowledge required – cheat

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sheets are provided! Helpers also needed to cut stamps up (at home), make photocopies, and more. Come travel the world with us!

Vision Screening – Help gather students when needed and guide through stations, as well as assist in testing with vision.

Popcorn Sales – Pop and sell popcorn on decided Friday afternoons (usually once per month) throughout the year.

Event Dates: Sep. 25, Oct. 23, Nov. 20, 2015; Jan. 22, Feb. 19, Mar. 18, May 20, 2016

Reading Incentive – Go For the Gold! This is Hiteon’s voluntary incentive program to encourage our students to read. Help track students’ reading hours and pass out prizes.

Science Fair – We start this great enrichment program with a fun kick-off assembly, and then small classroom presentations, collect sign up forms, and finally have a great evening event to view projects. Lots of opportunities to help: set up of event, reviewing projects, presentations, decorating bulletin board, displaying signs, and more.
