- Mrs. Logan reading tips

- Principal's Update: Meghan Warren
 - WiFi has been down in BSD and the district is working on it
 - Science Expo was phenomenal, with really great attendance as well!
 - Projected enrollment is approx. 686, very similar to this year, we will
 - 4 teachers have been allocated for Kindergarten, but that may change
 - 5 teachers for 1st grade, 4 for 2nd grade, 4 for 3rd grade, 4 for 4th grade, 5 for 5th grade
 - Goal is to keep the class size down as much as possible
 - Hiteon will be hosting "extended school year" this year. It's a Summer school program for special education students throughout the district. It's been approx. 4 years since we have hosted. This will mean that Hiteon will be vacated during July, so our playground and parking lot will need to be reserved for the school sessions during those times. Move in on June 22 - out on Aug. 1
 - Shout out to the PTC Board, the parents here are very great partners with helping our students.
- Budget (Courtney standing in for Jen.)
 - Movie matinee is completed, \$1820
 - Total 5th grade amount is at over \$1400 from concessions, bringing total close to \$2792
 - Bingo came in at \$500
 - Fun Run received a massive donation from Nike for T-Shirts (approx. 900 T-shirts) the expense is from the screen printing, the expense for screen printing needs to be marked as an advertising expense per our tax accountant. We strive to have our expenses for Fun Run be 10% of the amount that we hope to raise, now that the screen printing is going to fall under our expenses it may have an effect on that amount, however we are able to save in other areas so we expect to come ahead in money on the bottom line at the end of the year.

- Kindergarten grant request was approved
- Mascot bills have come in
- Follow up items,
 - Passport password
 - Passport maps are now online, and are password protected
 - We ask that teachers don't post the password on a public website
 - Little blue pieces of paper with the password are being sent home with kids, we also have spare maps in the office
 - OBOB Trophy
 - The trophy that's in the library will be updated, but we are waiting to see how they do in the state competition
 - Board and chair positions for next year, the dry-erase board is coming out and you can write your name on a slot you are interested in
 - Bingo night was a success, 400+ participated!
 - Science fair went really well!
 - Pizzicato \$790.40 raised, a little shy of the \$912 raised in the fall but still very well!

 - March 18th Coffee with the Principal will be rescheduled
 - Popcorn Friday
 - Spring Break for one week and a day, followed by Fun Run Kick-off
 - PTC Meeting will be earlier next week because of Fun Run, and the week of the Fun Run the 11th - 15th will be a Spirit Week.
 - We are looking for volunteers to help speak at the classes and measure kids for T-Shirts March 31st and April 1st (Thurs. and Friday) for the kick-off
