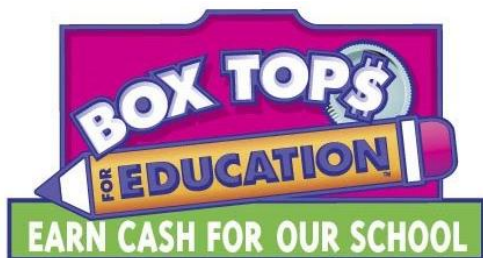
## Lost and Found
