

## What's Happened in Music This Year 2016-2017

This year at Hiteon, there were so many things that were accomplished. The instrument carts came and we were able to have an experience for the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grades on the clarinets. The Hiteon after school choir was a huge success and gave three performances, one of them being the choir festival at Southridge High School with three elementary school choirs and Conestoga Middle School and the high school choir joining us. The 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grades also just finished with the violins and we are finishing up the year with dances, drumming and multicultural games.

Mrs. McCulley announced in the last newsletter that she is retiring. She has been a wonderful addition to our staff and we hope that she will enjoy her retirement as she moves back to Eugene.

After thirty years of teaching in Beaverton, we will be saying goodbye to Mrs. Henry who is also retiring. She has spent the last five years here at Hiteon, twenty years at Nancy Ryles, and her first five years at Vose. Mrs. Henry has loved teaching all the students is very proud of the progress everyone has made and also is proud of the after school choir program. She has truly enjoyed her time at Hiteon, wishes everyone a very fond farewell and looks forward to seeing her students and families around the neighborhood.

### PARENTVUE ACCOUNTS

This fall, the Beaverton School District will be moving to paperless report cards for all middle and high school students. The report cards will be accessed through ParentVue.

In addition, the District will also be moving to online registration and enrollment verification. If you have not activated your ParentVue account, you will need to do that before the fall.

We realize there may be issues with access for some of our parents. There are resources and guidance on how to set up a ParentVue account. Contact the office for assistance.

Paperless report cards, registration and enrollment verification offer several benefits. Online registration and enrollment verification will be convenient and efficient for families. Parents of middle and high school students will be able to view grades two to three business days after grading days, rather than wait up to two weeks for a report card to come by mail. In addition, moving away from paper is environmentally friendly and cost-effective for the District.

Those families who still wish to receive a paper report card in the mail can opt-out. You will also be able to print the report card from home.

The District will be sending out additional communications about these changes throughout the summer and fall.

### BSD Summer Hours

Beaverton School District schools and departments will follow summer hours beginning Mon, June 26<sup>th</sup> through Fri, August 14<sup>th</sup>. Summer office hours are as follows:

- Administration Center – Mon–Thurs 7:30am–4:30pm
- Elementary school offices – Open regular hours Mon–Thurs through June 29<sup>th</sup>; Closed all of July; Open August 2<sup>nd</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> from 8:00am–12:00pm only; Regular hours resume beginning Mon, August 14<sup>th</sup>.
- Middle school offices – Effective Mon, June 26<sup>th</sup> – Thurs, August 10<sup>th</sup>, 7:30am–3:00pm. Mon–Thurs; Open regular hours beginning Mon, August 14<sup>th</sup>.
- High school offices - Effective Mon, June 26<sup>th</sup> – Thurs, August 10<sup>th</sup>, 9:00am–3:30pm. Mon–Thurs; Open regular hours, 7:00am–3:30pm, beginning Mon, August 14<sup>th</sup>. Schools will remain closed on Fri, August 18<sup>th</sup> to accommodate the Classified In-service for office and support staff.
