Third Grade Math Labs: Problems solved!

Hiteon's third graders solved thousands of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division problems this year participating in the math labs program.

Math labs provided a valuable opportunity for each student to practice various problem solving methods and strategies in small groups of four to six students. The students worked with volunteers for 27 weeks in these groups at a difficulty and pace specific to their level of mastery of math concepts ranging from addition to multiplying fractions.
