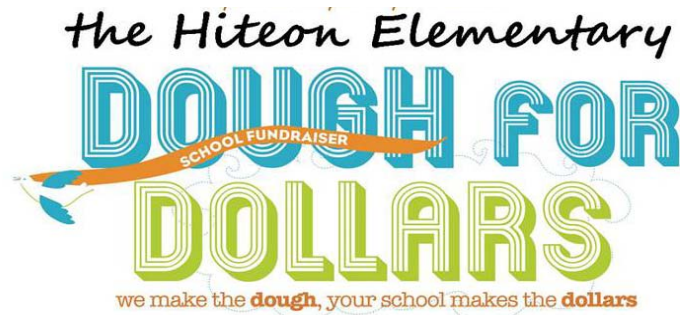
This meeting is open to everyone not just the head room party volunteer, so please come and bring your questions and your ideas. We will have handouts for you and go over the classroom budgets for the year.
