✿ 3rd Grade Math Labs ✿

Hello 3rd Grade Families,

3rd Grade MATH LABS needs YOU! If you can use a calculator, a pen, an answer key and stickers, YOU can make a difference in math labs! You do NOT need to be a math genius in order to help our kids each week with this valuable program. Here's how it works: We need 6 parent volunteers each **Thursday morning from 8-10 AM** to spend 20 minutes in each of 4 3rd grade classrooms (the 5th classroom will have a "bye" week on a rotating basis) working with a smaller group of similar-level kids on math practice worksheets and correcting math tests. The kids levels are pre-assessed, you have notebooks with the master worksheets and answer keys, and file folders with the correct set of worksheets in them for each 3rd grader. So EASY for you and so beneficial to boosting our 3rd graders math skills!

If this sounds like a great way for you to help out, please e-mail me ASAP! We are unable to start this invaluable program until we have a set of volunteers committed to these 6 days this fall. We really need to have a fairly consistent team of volunteers, but realize that 2 hours every Thursday morning can be a big commitment. If you can do every other week, once a month or just occasionally, please still sign up! We will have to cancel math labs if we do not have a minimum of 5 volunteers each week. We will not have math labs when the extended specials day falls on a Thursday, which happens twice this fall. SO, we need 3rd grade math labs volunteers on 10/16 then we have 2 weeks off due to conferences (10/23) and the specials rotation (10/30). We will need volunteers 11/6, 11/13, 11/20 then Thanksgiving is off. Back for 12/4 and 12/18 (12/11 is the specials rotation). 6 Thursdays in total this fall - can you help?

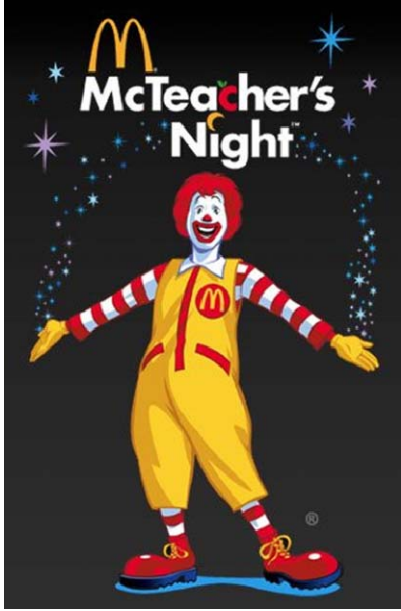
