Beaverton School Levy- Ballot measure 34-284- Becky Tymchuk

- School Board Rep- Represents our zone of South Beaverton.
- Option Levy- Levys are for operations. Dedicated to be used to pay for 300 teachers.
- If the levy passes, it will just be renewing the same tax for another 5 years. No change to what has been happening.
- \$1.25 for per \$1000 of assessed value. There are 5 certified staff at Hiteon that are funded through this levy.
- When you take teachers out it means more kids per class.
- 75% of people who live in the Beaverton school district do not have school age children.
- Election May 15

Principals Report- Monica Arbow

- Enrollment- 676- 31 who have joined us since January 1st. 23 new families.
- Staffing will be pretty consistent next year if the levy passes.
- .5 Student success coach- one of the last schools in the district to get one- the roll is to be a behavior support for teachers and students. Trauma support, etc.
- State testing is coming up. Starting April 30.
 - Modifications to the test- there's not a short answer. It's multiple choice. It's an hour shorter.
 - Performance task- essay- only 1 question instead of 3. Hopefully shave off 1 hour.
- Safety- SROs from Beaverton will be here on Friday to do additional training for teachers.
 - There needs to be parent/volunteer training for standard response protocol.
- Fun Run- Kids are excited
 - Coloring sheets are a hit
 - Assembly was fun and kids loved it
- Volunteer appreciation- April 26 at 1:00
 - o Invites will go out at the end of the week.

Budget- Megan Mumford

- Bingo- Insurance- approximately \$400
- Web Hosting Fee for 3 years- approximately \$400
- \$64,918 left in budget- Encourage teachers to use their funds and submit for grants.

- Stretchers are hardest one to sell.

Enrichment Programs- Marilee Shafer

- As a PTC we are looking at our programs to decide if we need to tweek or eliminate
- Survey sent out to teachers.
- Art Lit- support 100%
- Passport- needs most help. 68% support with changes. 22% said drop it all together.
 - Could it be optional
 - Pushed into classrooms instead of pulling kids out of class
 - Find someone from staff to meet with Aaron Sarver to rethink the program
- Reading Incentive- Go For the Gold
 - 87% in support
 - 8% wanting changes
 - o It is very volunteer heavy program and our current volunteers are just burned out.
 - Creating a form that is consistent across all grades/ages would help streamline counting.
 - We need a chair who has a passion for it and a teacher who can partner with them to work on it.
 - If we can't find a new chair by May/June it will probably get cut because we just don't have people interested in making it go.
- Science Expo- 100% support- Karl Meyer did a fantastic job this year.
- OBOB
 - Huge support from the teachers
 - 2018-19 the book *George* has some content that is concerning to some of the parents.
 - As a board we decided to fund OBOB in full for this year.
 - Making sure that we have parent feedback and input.
 - Monica- Looking at the possibility of sending home a letter to make parents aware of content of the book. Would mention that there is some content you might not be ready for your child to read.

- No teacher is going to make a child read a book if the parents aren't behind it.
- The school with work to create some safeguards so the book doesn't catch families by surprise.
