- Website renewal fees
 - \$14.99 for renewal of domain name
 - \$107.88 for website host

• Fun Run Update -

- We exceeded our goal of \$41,000!
 - As of this meeting, \$46,621.37 raised!
- Students who raised more than \$100 (193 students or 28% of the school) will receive their Fun Run t-shirts by Tuesday, May 27th
 - Idea proposed to have students (who earned Fun Run shirts) wear their Fun Run shirts for a designated day next year to promote the event for 2015's Fun Run
- o 672/694 students (94% of students) ran in the Fun Run
- Total laps ran: 28,065 (877 miles)!

- o Top boy and girl runners will participate in Water Balloon Toss on Field Day
- Top fundraising classes (Sonnen, Hastings, Maddux) will have their parties on Friday, May 30th
 - Sign up with Sue and Ilirija if you can help
 - Have teachers notify class parents if they would like to help
- Top fundraisers receive gift card of choice
- o Top fundraiser will have their day as the principal on Monday, June 9th
 - The top fundraiser collected \$531
- o Prize process (including the drawing, assembly and pick-up) went smoothly
- Art Lit Night Thursday, May 22nd
 - Low on volunteers, please sign up at stations (especially at the later/evening session)
 - o Provide a sign-in sheet to get a better feel for the number of attendees at each session
- Budget Review Erica
 - Current Budget 2013-2014 -
 - Income Items:
 - Income: everything is mostly on target
 - Fundraising: \$59,341.09 (excluding Red Robin Dining for Dollars and corporate matching)
 - Expenses:
 - PTC Website: exceeded budget due to setup and renewal fee occurring in same school year. Board agreed to pay this since it is within the \$500 limit of the by-laws. Next year will not have this issue as there will be just one renewal expense.
 - OMSI Golly-Ology Assemblies: there are 3 assemblies scheduled for Monday, June 9th
 - The cost exceeded budget by \$25. Board approved this overage as it is within the \$500 limit not requiring approval at a General Meeting.
 - Community Event: costs for the Art Night will come out of this line item
 - Approximately \$250-\$300
 - Draft Budget Review 2014-2015 -
 - Income
 - Broke out Amazon Smile, Fred Meyer Rewards and McTeacher Night
 - McTeacher Night funds goes to the specific staff who
 participated via their staff funds (this money does not roll over
 year to year, it must be used during the school year or it is
 rolled back into the big pot)
 - 5th Grade Party will be removed from our budget. We will let them set their own goals.
 - Not planning for additional t-shirt sales (there are both Hiteon and science fair t-shirts left over)
 - Goal for our major fundraising will be \$40,000
 - Expenses
 - Lowered PTC Misc. and moved the \$150 to PTC supplies
 - Increased website costs to \$125

- Increased tax budget up by \$25
- Lowered tech fund to \$10,000
 - o This \$5,000 will be split between:
 - Library support (updating materials and books)
 - A new line item to support the cultural component of PYP which will begin this next school year
- Dude Event will be removed from budget
- Increased Family Dance as it is well attended and is one of the two primary community events at the school
- 2014-2015 budget will not be finalized until the September General Meeting
- The proposed budget will be presented at the June General Meeting (per bylaws). Input encouraged.

 - o 1st: Hassold, Carlton, Christenson, and one opening
 - 24 students/class
 - o 2nd: Maddux, Walker, Brooks, Schmidt
 - 29 students/class
 - 3rd: Hastings, Snell, Castor, Wong, Nace
 - 25 students/class (has been 31 students/class)
 - 4th: Fouts, Chelf, Marr, and one opening
 - 29 students/class
 - 5th: Chamberlin, Humphrey, Steiwer, Klingner
 - 32 students/class
 - Additional .5 PE teacher and .5 Music teacher
 - PE and Music are attached to the curriculum and to learning targets
 - Will be hiring new PE and Music teachers for those .5 positions
 - 5 or 6 day rotation will begin next year with (1) double the current PE and Music, and (2) addition of .5 Mandarin/Chinese
 - The time out of the classroom for Specials will be almost identical to now, students will just get more PE and Music
 - More information to come on Mandarin and the cultural/language component of PYP
 - Job openings posted today. Interviews during the first of June
