BSD CLOTHES CLOSET IN NEED

The BSD Clothes Closet is in need of several high demand items.

As of 4/2/14, the Clothes Closet has served 1,617 students and has distributed more than 21,000 items of clothing to Beaverton students.



Treasurer's Update


As we head in to the last few months of school I want to provide an update on the 2013-2014 Hiteon PTC budget. As of April 1st, we have spent approximately 54% of our total budgeted expenses for the year. As seen in the chart below, the majority of money is spent on Staff and Classroom/School Support, followed by Programs and Events, Services, and PTC Related Expenses.

The Staff and Classroom/School Support category covers line items including the PTC Grant fund, Room Party funds, Special Purchases, Staff accounts, Technology and Library Support. As a portion of this overall support we have been able to purchase:

- 22 iPads
- 4 iMacs
- 18 Apple TVs
- Sound System for the Gym
- PYP Books and Materials for multiple classrooms

The Programs and Events category cover the costs for our community events like the Family Dance, BINGO, Donuts with Dudes, Science Fair and Art Night. It also provides the funds to support educational programs the students enjoy such as Art Literacy, Oregon Battle of the Books and Passport, as well as providing funds for assemblies.

The Services category provides funds for items like recess equipment replenishment, field trip scholarship money, hospitality, directory printing, clothes closet and staff appreciation throughout the year! Last, the PTC related Expenses category provides funds to cover the costs of running the PTC. As a 501 (c) 3, we incur costs related to handing our banking account, carrying insurance, tax filing, as well as supplies and the cost for the website which helps us keep the Hiteon community informed.



As we look towards our major fundraiser, the Fun Run, please remember that your financial support helps make all this possible. The money raised now helps us support the education of our Hiteon Students in many ways.
