Discussion Topics

1. Budget Review: Megan M. is approving most recent reimbursement requests – should be done by next week, and will also deposit Fun Run corporate sponsorships.
 - Review Grant Requests
 - i. 4th and 5th grade want Lion King kids play. Requesting \$350. \$150 for costumes and stage make-up, remainder (\$200) for scholarships to pay the \$40 fee to participate for whoever may be unable to pay. Event will be in March?
 1. We have \$2607 in the grant fund.
 2. It's a production that will benefit the whole school. There will be several performances.
 3. Could take it out of special purchases. We may not want to take it out of grant fund, which goes toward educational things.
 4. Would like to create a line item for this in future years.
 5. We will support this request.
 - ii. Jenny Rogers and Kindergarten team:
 1. Requesting \$620 – Science program through THPRD Nature program - “Amazing Adaptations” for all Kindergartners. Related to PYP.
 2. This will reduce fee from \$13 to \$7 per person. Asking for it out of grant money.
 3. Does the Kindergarten team know that the curriculum fund exists? They have \$1473 to use. Teachers may not realize that they already have this money.

4. They don't need our approval to use their curriculum funds, just need approval from principal. We like the idea, but want to make sure they know they have this other money. If it is denied by principal for curriculum fund, then we will support out of grant fund.
- iii. Maryanne Hassold – 1st grade
 1. Requesting \$312 to support set of 5 books per first grade class.
 2. \$1300 available in curriculum support funds. Board approves it coming out of 1st grade curriculum.

 - Amy is drafting an email to go out to all the parents about all things Fun Run. Alicia will work with Marti to sending out email.
 - Sponsorship deadline is currently February 28
 - We at about \$1700 in corporate sponsorships so far.

- Shirts – need to shop around. Have a lead on a good deal through a Hiteon parent.
 - Will the print shop require a letter of permission from the businesses to be allowed to use/print their logos.
5. Facebook administrator
- Sarah Parsons has stepped back from this role. She is still doing website. We need someone to take over Facebook. Not a lot of work.
 - Involves creating an event/sharing an event, could attach Smore newsletter, dining for dollars flyers.
 - Carrie will do it through the end of the year, with hopes of recruiting Communications Chairperson.
