Discussion Topics

1. Middle School Attendance Boundary (MSBA) project for the Beaverton School District: Information presented by Steven Sparks, Executive Administrator for Long-Range Planning
 - What's going on with Middle School Boundary Adjustment and why it matters to you?
 - i. **REQUEST/ACTION:** Visit the district webpage, search for middle school boundary adjustment, submit a comment, and say what you think about what might happen for Hiteon.
 - ii. Middle school boundary adjustment all happening up in the North end of the district, will have cascading consequences across the district. New middle school, Timberland, needs to have about 800 students in it, and create a boundary around it. Stoller Middle School is way too big currently. Changes will have repercussions across the district.
 - iii. For Hiteon – could mean that everything stays the same, or could mean that Hiteon could move to sending ½ students to Highland, ½ to Conestoga.
 - iv. About 1800 comments currently submitted online, about 1700 of them are from the northern schools in the district.
 - v. In absence of comments, the decision will be made for us.
 - vi. Question and discussion around “legacy status” for students already attending a school when the boundaries change. This is currently being discussed by the advisory committee.
 - vii. District in general tries to move whole elementary school student bodies to a single middle school, if/when they can.

- viii. Advisory Committee hopes to issue recommendation to superintendent by Spring Break. Superintendent to make recommendation in early May. School Board to make decision in June. Have one full year to implement plan, and the change will go into effect for the 2021-2022 school year.
2. Principal's report - Meghan Warren
 - Staff is working to declutter their plate and working on keeping morale boosted as a staff.
 3. Margie True: Teacher Update
 - Question about math labs for 3rd and 4th grade – is there interest from 3-5th grade teachers for this program? PTC wondering if there will be a need to find volunteers for this next year.
 - Adoption of a different math curriculum (Kathy Fozno), math workshop model, doesn't really fit with Math Labs.
 - **ACTION:** Margie will investigate and provide teacher feedback.
