Discussion Topics

- 1. Approval of By-laws
 - a. Member-at-Large
 - i. Change that we are proposing is to appoint a Member-at-Large with a term commitment of two years.
 - ii. Article V. Executive Board, Section 1 a.
 - 1. The Executive Board shall be of the officers of the Organization, the Volunteer Coordinator(s), the Principal, and three (3) but no more than six (6) members at-large.
 - a. Appointed Members At-Large (MALs). At least three (3) but no more than six (6) appointed MALs shall be appointed by the president and approved by the Executive Board. MALs shall be appointed in order to bring a particular knowledge base, skill set, or diversity to the board. They shall assume office after their approval by the executive board at the first board meeting following convention. They shall serve a term of two (2) years or until their successors are elected.
 - iii. Note that the Executive board consists of Board members plus volunteer coordinator, principal, and up to six members at large.
 - iv. Decision: Motion to approve addition of Member-at-Large amendment to By-laws, seconded and approved unanimously.
 - v. Edie Yi appointed as first Member-at-Large to the Hiteon PTC board.
